Emily was taken to the *intensive care unit for *premature babies.

The doctor sat down at the edge of Kate’s bed, still holding Jamie, who was now wrapped in a blanket. The doctor began talking to Kate, but she was not listening to a word he said.

“I don’t want him wrapped in that blanket by himself while he passes (C).” she thought.

Then Kate asked her husband to take off his shirt, so that both of them could hold him close and he could feel the *warmth of their skin. After all, he had just spent months inside the *warmth of his mother’s body, hearing her heart beat.
